

Prize for a promising researcher in Gerontology or Geriatrics

At the 25th Congress of Gerontology in Reykjavik, June 2020, the NGF prize for promising researcher in Gerontology or Geriatrics will be handed out for the 4th time. The prize is intended for a researcher from Denmark.

The proposed candidate shall not hold a senior position but should preferably have concluded a PhD.

A member association of NGF can nominate the candidate to the prize. Argumentation and a CV must follow. No direct applications will be accepted.

- The prize-winner will receive an amount of 20.000 SEK and give a lecture in the 25th NKG.
- The prize-winner will not pay any registration fee at the 25th congress. Expenses for travel (in economy if by flight) and accommodation during the congress will be paid by NGF.
- The jury for the prize consists of the president and two vice presidents of the NGF and the chairs of the scientific committees in the current and for the next congress.
